#### **Regional Logistics Plan Regional**

As advised during the last Approval Authority meeting on February 9, 2012, URS Corporation was identified as the vendor for the Regional Logistics Plan and contract negotiations are in progress. A regional steering committee of stakeholders, subject matter experts and RCPGP Planners (City of Oakland, San Francisco, Marin and Santa Clara Counties) will be established to work with both the Cal EMA Project Lead and RCPGP Program Manager on this project.

#### **Catastrophic Incident Training/Exercise Project**

The Training and Exercise Program is currently awaiting completion of the MOU process. The Regional UASI Training and Exercise website currently has the ability to accept registration for RCPGP desired training requests.

#### **Regional Public Outreach and Community Preparedness Project Plan**

The Project Leads for the Building Community Readiness and Resiliency Program (Alexis Amaye-Hunter - Oakland) and Get Ready 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Bay Area (Angela DelPonte -San Rafael) have been working hard and completed their proposed work plans for these two pilot projects which are attached to this report for informational purposes. Once completed, both projects will



be evaluating their program models for possible long term implementation and sustainability on a regional basis.
