#### **B.** CBRNE-Quick Start Training

Beginning December 8th through 10th the Bay Area UASI Region in cooperation with the Domestic Nuclear Detection Office (DNDO) will be sponsoring a Preventative Rad/Nuc Detection "3-Day Quick Start" course for law enforcement personnel and hazardous materials team members whose agencies are participating in the Region's Preventative Radiological/Nuclear Detection Program. This threeday Rad/Nuc Quick Start course will focus on threat awareness and radiation detection equipment applications within the preventive radiological/nuclear detection (PRND) mission functions. Sealed radioactive sources will be utilized in practical equipment exercises to reinforce detection, identification, and alarm adjudication concepts. This course allows the Program to go operational before the end of 2014 and be a template for later PRND training and exercises.
