- C. Grant Year 2010 There was quite a bit of money returned to UASI from jurisdictions that were unable to spend it. Remember, 2012 has a 2-year performance period so we want to find out sooner rather than later if a project will not be able to be completed.
- D. 2013 Project Proposals All 2013 Project Proposals will be heard in their perspective Hubs this month. If you have a project, we strongly suggest that you attend this meeting to give an overview of that project. All projects will be ranked and then moved to the Advisory Group for recommendation to the Approval Authority. The Approval Authority will then consider project approvals at their March meeting.
